KCGM Pours 57 Millionth Ounce of Gold

KCGM has marked yet another milestone with the pouring of the 57th Millionth ounce of gold from the Golden Mile since it was first discovered and pegged by Sam Pearce and William Brookman in 1893. This translates to 15.2 million ounces directly from the KCGM operation.

KCGM General Manager Russell Cole said, “This pour reflects another significant milestone in gold production for the Goldfields region.”

“The Golden Mile has been mined for 120 years. The fact we are still here and mining today is an amazing achievement.”

KCGM has been achieving record pours ever since the company originated in 1989. The company’s first million ounces were poured at its Fimiston Gold Room on September 18th 1992.

Each year KCGM produces around 700,000 ounces of gold.
