KCGM Safety Bonus Benefits Local Children in Need

KCGM employees and contractors have voted to donate their latest safety bonus to the Annual Kalgoorlie Children in Care Christmas Party, run by the Government of Western Australia Department of Communities.

KCGM reached 1 million hours without a Lost Time Injury (LTI), meaning no one was absent from work due to a work related injury or illness during this time. Over a number of years KCGM employees have nominated to donate their safety bonus, this time donating \$12,000 to a worthy community cause.

“There are approximately 130 children in care in the local district and the Christmas party organisers rely heavily on local organisation support. It’s great that KCGM can ensure those, who are some of the most vulnerable in the community, can receive a happy and memorable Christmas experience,” said KCGM General Manager Cecile Thaxter.
