5. MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting held 8th August 2013 were moved by Kevin Smallhorn and seconded by Jim Watson.

7. AGENDA ITEMS

General Manager's Update (Russell Cole)

- Overview of performance for the third guarter of 2013.
- Safety:
 - 1 Lost Time Injury (LTI), 2 High Potential Incidents, 1 LTI and 6 Significant Potential Events.
 - KCGM reported the top 5 site fatality risks.
- Environment and Social Responsibility:
 - One million man hours reached without an LTI. The \$10,000 bonus is being donated to the Goldfields Rehabilitation Service.
 - Mount Charlotte 50th birthday tours continue; around 150 visitors on the underground tours.
 - Continuing development of the KCGM Integrated Management System
 - ISO14001 Audit being conducted in October. Focused on four key environmental management areas; emissions, tailings, water, noise and vibration.
 - 1 Environmental incident (SO₂).
 - Presentation given on Dust Management at KCGM.
- Physicals:
 - Open Pits on budget with material moved and ore tonnes.
 - Mount Charlotte currently over budget.
 - Head grade is slightly under budget due to lower ore tonnes.
 - Gold Recovery is slightly down.

- Vital Behaviors:
 - 1,120 employees and contractors committed to Vital Behaviors.
 - The aim is to identify the behaviors required to improve safety across site.

Environment Reporting (Graeme Smith)

- Notable Incidents:
 - One SO₂ event was recorded at the Hannans Golf Course Monitoring Station. Reading was 0.216ppm which is over the Environmental Protection Policy (EPP) Standard of 0.20ppm (maximum limit is 0.25ppm) Investigation ongoing to determine the source.
- Dust Management at KCGM:
 - Dust is monitored by The Fimiston Air Quality Management Plan.
 - KCGM has 7 dust monitoring sites.
 - Thermo Beta Attenuation Monitors (BAM) are used to monitor the dust levels.
 - All dust events above the NEPM standard are reported to the DER and DoH within seven days.
 - KCGM prevents dust by using water trucks 24 hrs a day, progressive rehabilitation, delaying work as required and additional control measures such as dust binding agents.
 - 24 hour dust averages are available on the KCGM website.
 - A graph showing 2013 performance against the NEPM standard of 50 ug/m3 was shown to the CRG.

Social Responsibility (Jacqui Niemand)

Activities in September:

- KCGM had 24 recorded public interactions, including 2 complaints: Blast vibration (2).
- 127 visitors have been on the Mt Charlotte underground tours and 44 copies of the historical DVD sold.
- CRG Survey results:
 - 11 CRG members responded to the survey.
 - Environmental impacts and health, education and welfare of local residents are the most important to the CRG members.
 - Majority prefer monthly meetings at midday and that membership should be terminated if members are consistently unable to attend.

8. GENERAL BUSINESS

BR requested information about Hannans North Tourist Mine being open on weekends. JN advised that KCGM has recently employed a new team member who will start opening the shop on Sundays once their training is complete.

KS asked for an update on Hannans North visitors. JN advised that we are up to about 2,000 visitors per month which is a dramatic increase from Burt Street location.
