4. MINUTES

6. AGENDA ITEMS

Tailings Storage Facilities (Jess Dudley / Mark van Maanen)

- Tailings overview:
 - A tour of the Fimiston II tailings storage facility was provided to the CRG members.
 - The tailings slurry is fundamentally the material left behind once all the gold has been recovered into gold bullion.
 - Currently there are four active tailings storage facilities at KCGM.
 Since 1999, KCGM has significantly increased the groundwater depth trends.
 - Ongoing monitoring indicates there has not been negative impacts to vegetation around the TSF's.
- Future projects:
 - KCGM is seeking approval to increase the height of the Fimiston II TSF as additional capacity is required.
 - Mining Proposal and Works Approval applications are currently being prepared for submission in Quarter 2, 2013. To enable planned deposition strategy to commence, approval is required by 2015.
 - Fimiston I is near maximum capacity. There is 25million tonne remaining capacity at Fimiston II and 50million tonne remaining capacity at Kaltails.
 - Fimiston II height increase will provide an extra 56Million tonne capacity which will meet requirements to 2023.

Environment Reporting (Michelle Berryman)

- Incidents:
 - One SO₂ incident which is being investigated.
 - A monitoring bore recorded water level at less than two meters after heavy rainfall.
 - Two dead birds were found in the Gidji II TSF netting and one swan was captured in the pit and released.

Social Responsibility (Michelle Berryman)

Activities in March:

- 20 volunteer hours for Boulder Market Day.
- 27 Media reports in March, 7 positive, 19 neutral and 1 negative.
- There was sponsorship donation approved in March with a value of \$212.
- In March KCGM had 52 recorded public interactions, 9 were complaints: SO₂(8), and Road Safety (1).
- An overview of the past 6 months of Super Pit Shop visitors and proceeds was shown.
 - 924 visitors visited the Super Pit Shop in March.
