Social Responsibility (Jacqui Niemand)

Activities in May:

- Videos currently being developed include, HR attraction, Mt Charlotte 50 years and one on how KCGM manages and monitor pit wall stability.
- Consultations held in May:
 - Loopline ramp construction;
 - Wendy Duncan MP and Nationals Candidate Chub Witham visited the Super Pit Shop and Hannans North Tourist Mine; and
 - Familiarisation of Hannans North Tourist Mine for local tourist providers.
- 37 media reports, 8 positive, 26 neutral and 1 negative.
- 2 sponsorships, 1 Grant and 2 Donations approved in May with a total value of \$37,424

- Air Quality:
 - A graph was shown to the CRG that gave a comparison of monthly Gidji roaster shutdowns due to Air Quality Control.
 - Due to unfavorable weather conditions during winter, roasting time is greatly reduced.
 - KCGM adheres to tight restrictions under the Air Quality Strategy.
