#### General Manager's Update: Overview of performance for the third quarter of 2014 (lan Butler).

- Safety:
  - Four Restricted Work Injuries (RWI) in July and August.
  - Two High Potential Incidents (HPI) and seven Significant Potential Events (SPE).
- Physicals:
  - Open Pits slightly down on material moved, ore tonnes moved was good.
  - Mount Charlotte is performing very well.
  - Processing slightly under budget with tonnes milled.
  - Shipped and recovered ounces tracking well.
- Hidden Secret Update
  - Mining Plans have been developed for the Hidden Secret Project.
  - Documentation being finalized for the DMP and EPA.
  - Hidden Secret information sheet available on the KCGM website.
- Full Potential
  - The program aims to improve cost-efficiency and help secure KCGM's long-term future.
  - Projects have been implemented across site and are progressing well.
- Vital Behaviors
  - Vital Behaviors Family visits were a great success with 120 families participating.

# **Environment Reporting (Michelle Berryman)**

- Notable Incidents:
  - Six dust events above the NEPM standard. Regulators advised. Two were regional dust events and it is likely that KCGM was the primary contributor for four. Operations were modified and water carts used to suppress dust.
  - Noise Amelioration Programme is tracking well. Stage one, Design, is completed and Stage two, implementation, is progressing well.

## Social Responsibility (Michelle Berryman)

- There were 35 public interactions recorded in October, including one complaint regarding SO<sub>2</sub>.
