**7. AGENDA ITEMS**

**General Manager's Update (Ian Butler)**

- Safety:
  - One Restricted Work Injury (RWI) and one Lost Time Injury (LTI) in February.
  - Four Significant Potential Events (SPE) and two High Potential Incidents (HPI) in February.
- Physicals:
  - Shipped ounces are slightly down.
  - Overall we are tracking well.
- Fimiston Mill February 15-day shut down went well.

**Environment Reporting (Michelle Berryman)**

- Notable Incidents:
  - Six dust events above the NEPM standard in February. KCGM not a significant contributor to these events.
- Dust Management at KCGM:
  - Dust is monitored and managed in accordance with the Fimiston Air Quality Management Plan.
  - KCGM has 7 dust continuous monitoring sites.
  - All dust events above the NEPM standard are reported to the DER and DoH within seven days.
  - KCGM prevents dust by using water trucks 24 hrs a day, progressive rehabilitation, delaying work as required and additional control measures such as dust binding agents.
  - 24 hour dust averages are available on the KCGM website.
  - Low rainfall in the Goldfields so far this year has resulted in increased dust from all sources.
- Gidji Emissions Reduction Project is tracking well.
  - The new Ultra Fine Grinding Mill (UFG) has been installed at Gidji ahead of schedule.
  - One roaster was closed during February.
  - Roaster infrastructure removal will start in 2015.
- Hidden Secret Project is still being assessed by the EPA.

### Social Responsibility (Jacqui Niemand)

- There is currently 3 Blast Damage Inspections in progress.
- Ongoing engagement with one Williamstown resident regarding Asbestos, SOB Vent Fan and Conveyor Noise.
- A revised agreement with the Loopline Society is being finalised.
- Murray Joyce will be giving a Safety Presentation to key KCGM employees and contractors at their Safety Meetings onsite during March.
- Current projects:
  - New KCGM Website is under development.
  - The Lookout re-vamp is due to be completed by the end of March 2015.
- Hannans North update:
  - The KCGM Exit Strategy is being developed in 2015.
