# **General Manager's Update: (Mark Barrett)**

- Overview of performance:
  - Safety:
    - No injuries during April.
    - 1,336 Safety Interactions were completed during April across site.
    - The Fimiston Processing Plant dual shutdown held in April went well.
  - Physicals:
    - Ounces produced were in line with budget.
    - Underground ore tonnes were slightly behind budget.
    - · Open pit total movement above budget.
    - X ramp wall failure remediation completed.
    - Overall costs are tracking well for April.
- Business and Administration department overview:
  - Team of 35 people with three core functions; Supply Chain, Information and Communications Technology and Finance.

- The Supply Chain manages three areas; Warehouse, Contracts and Procurement.
- Information and Communications Technology manages internet, desktops, network, servers and user support.
- Finance manages accounting, payroll, business planning, accounts payable and capital.

# KCGM Social Impact Assessment Process and Outcomes (Jacqui Niemand)

- The presentation that was provided to Newmont in Denver was presented to the CRG.
- This is the fourth SIA conducted by KCGM to gauge public perceptions about the operations.
- KCGM has 6 phases of the SIA that have been completed over the past 8 months. The SIA is now in its final stages.
- 11 impacts have been identified from the SIA which will assist KCGM in developing strategic plans for the next 3 years.
- KCGM had a good overall performance score of 3.8 out of 5 and an overall performance rating of 3.8 out of 5 throughout all impact categories.
- Once finalised:
  - The SIA results will be communicated to key stakeholders;
  - A development of SIA Plan workshops will be completed;
  - A SIA IMS working group will be formed; and
  - An update of Stakeholder Engagement Strategy will be completed.
