Local Voices lends a hand to Kalgoorlie-Boulder community groups

KCGM's Local Voices initiative will extend extra support to Kalgoorlie-Boulder community groups and leaders through the first Pulse survey, available online until Sunday 10 May.

KCGM General Manager Kous Kirsten said the survey had been structured to collate community concerns in response to COVID-19, equipping KCGM and local groups to better respond to the crisis.

"We understand the Kalgoorlie-Boulder community and local businesses are experiencing unprecedented and extremely difficult circumstances as a result of COVID-19," Kous said.

"As a small gesture, Voconiq, in partnership with KCGM, are doubling donations local community groups can receive for every completed Local Voices survey this quarter."

"Every completed survey is worth \$10 in donations, directly supporting local groups who are facing unique challenges during this tough time."

"Local Voices is an ongoing community engagement initiative for KCGM, helping our business to better understand and respond to community sentiment relating to KCGM's operations."

Over 400 residents participated in the 2019 KCGM Local Voices Anchor Survey, and this is anticipated to grow through each quarterly Pulse survey in 2020.
