Below are confirmations of two specimens that you recently forwarded to the W.A. Herbarium:

LEN04-10 *Streptoglossa liatroides*
PRN005-12 *Streptoglossa liatroides*

This morphotype is has been referred to *S. liatroides* var. *repens*. In the last revision of the genus Dunlop suggested that taxon was not circumscribable as a distinct entity and treated it merely as representing clinal infraspecific variation. Dunlop's revision is now over 40 years old and it would be an interesting exercise to revisit the issue in the light of the much larger specimen base now available as there does still seem to be a prima facie case for its recognition. A complicating factor however is the fact that the species also occurs in NT, SA and NSW as well as WA. It would therefore take a good deal of work to be confident enough of the taxonomic ground to reinstate it.
